

# BRITISH MEDIUM TRIUMPHS IN USA TV DEBUT

## His phone never stops ringing

The last part of the programme (October 26) was devoted to a chair test, describing beforehand who would occupy a designated seat, and guest appearances by Mary Ellen and Alvin Steiner from

Allentown. They testified to the many tapes they have received from Hearn with recorded proof of their son's survival after death.

The medium's press representative and photographer on the tour, George Burns (not to be confused with the cigar-smoking TV star of the same name) told me:

"His TV show was a big success. The response has been tremendous, with the phone here at the house ringing all day."

### Response is "fantastic"

"The studio was even more busy," Hearn told me on the transatlantic telephone. "Its phone was ringing before the show was over. They said they were delighted with the fantastic response to the show which exceeded anything previously experienced by them."

Hearn added: "The trip is creating great interest. All the lectures have been attended by capacity crowds."

"After each meeting we are besieged with requests for private sittings."

Describing his arrival at Philadelphia airport, the medium said, "George took my picture and everyone thought I was a VIP."

Edith Roman, organiser of Hearn's six-week USA and Canadian tour, was there to greet him and to escort him to a champagne reception arranged by her. "It was super," enthused the medium.

Hearn opened his lecture and

broadcast tour in New York when he spoke at a packed Madison Avenue venue. It was a most successful opening according to those present.

Letters are arriving at Hearn's London home in praise of his work from grateful audiences in the New York, New Jersey and Pennsylvania areas.

Hearn's second TV appearance was on Monday, again in Philadelphia. This time he was guest on the "Connie Roussin Show," which has a top two-day transmission.

He has several other TV and radio broadcasts lined up, as well as some "possibles" should his schedule allow.

### Broadcast to world

His Canadian appearances will involve two separate trips. The first on November 11 is to tape a TV show in Toronto.

The second, to Montreal, will include recording a programme to be sent all over the world by Radio Canada.

This will follow his final USA appearance when he will lecture and demonstrate clairvoyance at a large meeting arranged by the Steiners in Allentown.

Anne Kovalenko, journalist on "Allentown Call Chronicle," who will cover the meeting, also hopes to arrange local radio and TV broadcasts.
